THE MINISTER FOR EXTERNAL RELATIONS makes this Order under Article 19(1)(h) of the [Charities \(Jersey\) Law 2014](#) –

1 Interpretation

In this Order, “the Law” means the [Charities \(Jersey\) Law 2014](#).

2 Reportable matters: prescribed descriptions

- (1) For the purposes of the Law (and in addition to the matters listed in Article 19(1)(a) to (g) of the Law), each of the following is a reportable matter in relation to a person –
 - (a) the fact that the person has a conviction (whether or not spent) for an offence against a vulnerable person;
 - (b) the fact that the person has an unspent conviction for an offence (unless the fact that the person has the conviction is a reportable matter under subparagraph (a) or under Article 19(1)(f) or (g) of the Law).
- (2) In paragraph (1)(a), “an offence against a vulnerable person” means an offence where the victim of the offence was, at the time the offence was committed –
 - (a) under the age of 18; or
 - (b) aged 18 or older and –
 - (i) had a mental disorder within the meaning of the [Mental Health \(Jersey\) Law 2016](#);
 - (ii) had a significant impairment of intelligence and social functioning; or
 - (iii) had a physical disability or a physical disorder.

3 Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Charities (Reportable Matters) (Jersey) Order 2025 and comes into force on 1 June 2025.
